NEFAP Executive Committee (NEFAP EC) Meeting Summary November 20, 2024

1. Roll call, Agenda and Meeting Minutes Review:

Tracy Szerszen, Chair, called the NEFAP Executive Committee to order on November 20, 2024, at 1pm Eastern. Attendance is included in Attachment A - there were 7 NEFAP EC committee members present and 2 Associate members. Jerry Parr also attended.

There were no changes to the agenda, and it was approved by unanimous consent.

The October 16, 2024, minutes were reviewed. Kim's attendance at the meeting needs to be added. A motion was made by Anand to approve the October 16, 2024 minutes as written with the attendance correction. The motion was seconded by Katie and unanimously approved.

2. Strategic Planning Meeting

A strategic planning meeting will be held in Jacksonville the day before the winter conference. Jerry provided a copy of the 2019 worksheet used for the last strategic planning meeting 5 years ago. It needs to be updated. A small group volunteered to help: Ilona, Kevin, Shannon, Tracy, Kim and Katie. Tracy suggested that Justin may want to also help.

Ilona suggested looking at the original document from 2019 where there was discussion about expanding into markets beyond environmental. Back then that was discouraged and some of the information may have been removed. Jerry noted that this is something the Program can look into. The new workgroups and focus on training will also need to be reflected in the new worksheet.

3. Presentations

Water Environment Association of Texa (WEAT) – Elizabeth, Tracy, Katie

The online webinar presentation went well. WEAT mentioned having us out at the next face-to-face meeting. WEAT sent out the links with the presentations to members.

Pacific Northwest Pre-Treatment Workshop - Jeff

There were about 250 people attendance – many EPA people and regulators. Jeff noted someone from Chicago reached out to his co-worker that presented. She wanted more

information. The presentation was well received. This is an annual conference in the Fall. One way the presentation could be improved is to add more case studies.

Adding accreditation gives credibility to their work. Not a lot of people knew about NEFAP.

EPA - Anand

Anand has not had any follow-up since the meetings he discussed last month. He will begin follow-up next week and look for more meeting/speaking opportunities.
