NEFAP Executive Committee (NEFAP EC) Meeting Summary June 26, 2024

1. Roll call, Agenda and Meeting Minutes Review:

Tracy Szerszen, Chair, called the NEFAP Executive Committee to order on June 26, 2024, at 2:30pm Eastern. Attendance is included in Attachment A - there were 9 NEFAP EC committee members present and 3 Associate members. Jerry Parr also attended.

There were no changes to the agenda and it was approved by unanimous consent.

A motion was made by Justin to approve the May 15, 2024 meeting minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Kevin and unanimously approved.

2. Membership

Tracy asked people to let her know if they would be interested in filling the Vice-Chair role.

3. Field Conclave

The Conclave went well and had all sessions were filled. There were 50 registrations.

Jerry shared the budget on screen and NEFAP is doing well.

The NEFAP EC will combine their meeting with FAC in Garden Grove. Tracy hopes to brainstorm ideas for the next workshop in Fall. It looks like the shorter workshops may work better for attendees than the 3-day Conclaves.

Katie agreed that the shorter workshops are easier. Three days out of the field is an issue. It is also easier to do a single topic. Justin agreed with Katie. More frequent one day works better. 2-4 a year would work well.

Workshop Ideas:

- Jerry had an idea for a workshop – the methylene chloride rule was passed – safety related. It is in effect now with a 90-day implementation period. ACIL is trying to convince them to give 3 years to meet exposure requirements in environmental laboratories. It is an EPA regulation ... not an OSHA regulation. Jerry will do a little more work on this and discuss at the July meeting.

- EPA is coming out with 1621 and 1633 late this fall as a proposed rule. There are some sampling issues, composite sampling sampling for PFAS in wastewater.
- Passive samplers
- EMF a lot of interest in air sensors. Anand may be a good contact on this.
- ASTM came out with two new standards. Ambient air quality sensors. Jerry will talk to Raul in CA.

Perhaps the schedule for these shorter workshops could be October, last half of February and mid-June. The June meeting could still be a multi-speaker workshop, but for 1 day instead of 3 days.

4. Summer Meeting

There will be a joint session with FAC.

- Where the Standard is.
- Feedback on what people want to see.
- Talk about future workshops.
- Re-Cap on PFAS?

Any additions needed to the agenda should be mentioned to Stacie.

5. Internal Audit Training

A lot of work has been done, but everyone is over committed. The internal audit section has changed in the new Standard. Should they wait to do this training?

Shannon is still willing to help. One method has been to write a script and the other is to use the slides and expand during the presentation.

Should the class be shortened into multiple classes. Need to look at the materials and see if something like this will work. Katie and Ilona will take a look at the material.

6. Evaluations

One partial application has been submitted.

7. Status of Field Standard

The Volume 1 Field Standard is just about ready for a final vote. Katie is working on the Change Summary.
