4. Language for Volume 1 Module 2 Lab Standard

Tracy pulled up DRAFT language to send to the Quality Management Systems (QMS) Expert Committee. Ilona noted that "other appropriate documents" is too vague. Need to give a few examples. Sampling plans, SOPs, etc

After further input, Tracy and Patrick decided to send the following language for the QMS Expert Committee to consider:

Section 7.3.4 Labs performing field sampling activities shall define the competence requirements of personnel and authorize personnel to perform sampling. Where an external sampling organization is used, the laboratory shall have procedures to ensure that the experience and technical competence of the samplers are sufficient for sampling activities and that they comply with the relevant clauses of this document and other sampling documents (i.e. sampling plans, sampling methods, regulatory documents, etc.). Use of NEFAP Accredited Sampling Organizations meets these requirements.

While in Minneapolis, Tracy would like to ask how a NELAP state is going to accredit for sampling?

Some states are currently doing mobile lab, but not sampling accreditation.

5. Metrics

Tracy summarized the changes she made to the metrics table in preparation to submit it to the Board.
