Summary of the NELAP Accreditation Council Session Monday, February 6, 2023 1:30 pm Eastern

1. Welcome and Introductions

Kristin welcomed everyone to the meeting. Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1. The minutes of December 2, 2022, and January 10, 2023, were approved as presented.

2. Election of Chair and Nominations for Vice Chair

Kristin turned the meeting over to Michele for the election of Chair. There were no additional nominations for the position. Cathy moved and Travis seconded that Kristin be re-elected to the position, and approval was unanimous. Congratulations, Kristin!

With that business concluded, Michele turned the meeting back to Kristin for Vice Chair nominations. This election will be voted at the April meeting. Carl nominated Michele to continue as Vice Chair; Michele agreed to accept the nomination, and Cathy seconded it. Additional nominations will still be accepted.

3. Renewal Recommendation for Louisiana Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program

The evaluation team's recommendation for renewal of LELAP was distributed to Council members on December 13, 2022, but this is the first business meeting since that time. With no issues raised for discussion, Travis moved and Carl seconded that the recommendation be approved. With full attendance, the vote for approval was unanimous with Louisiana abstaining.

4. Renewal Recommendation for Illinois

This recommendation was just received and distributed on February 4, so that only a few hours on Monday morning would have been available for its review. It was the consensus of all participants that additional time was needed and Kristin determined that this recommendation would be tabled until the March meeting of the Council. One participant noted that there would likely be some discussion requested about the non-conformity relating to third party assessor use, and the process used to determine their competency.

5. Presentation of ORELAP's IT Systems Used to Manage the Program

Travis had offered to do this presentation in the fall of 2022, and February was the first meeting to have time on the agenda for it. The system is referred to as the ORELAP Data Input and Entry database (ODIE), and it manages the laboratory assessment records and the laboratory fields of accreditation. ODIE is the application through which labs apply for accreditation and renewals, and it also generates the draft assessment reports based on assessment records entered. Microsoft Teams was used for screen-sharing, and a series of screen-shots were distributed for participants who might not be able to view the screen online.

Participants were intrigued by the application, and a follow-up email discussion inquired about other in-house systems and the one commercially available AB management system.

6. Discussion of SIR 412

This SIR discussion was carried over from the December 2022 meeting. Two ABs had requested discussion. The primary issue was about whether "prepared" applies only to reagents prepared in the laboratory, or to standards prepared in the lab, but after discussion, all agreed that the way the Standard is worded could be read in a broad or a narrow sense, but that an interpretation cannot clarify that without adding additional language to the Standard, which is not permitted. The discussion requests have been removed.

7. Next Meeting

The next scheduled teleconference meeting of the NELAP AC is scheduled for <u>Monday</u>, <u>March 6, 2023, at 1:30 pm Eastern</u>. An agenda and documents will be provided in advance.
