Proposed Title for Guidance: Selecting and Approving Suitable Laboratory Supplies and Services

Form of Proposed Guidance: Guidance Document in the Form of a manual.

Purpose of Proposed Guidance: Provide guidance to laboratories on means to comply with purchasing requirements of EL V1M2

Does the Proposed Guidance Interprets or Helps Implement of Comply with a TNI Standard Requirement? Provides mechanisms for laboratories to effectively illustrate to AB during assessment that supplies and/or services utilized by the laboratory can provide certification of acceptability in compliance with EL V1M2, Section 4.6.

Summary of Proposed Guidance Content: Document being developed to assist laboratories in compliance with requirements of EL V1M2 regarding Section 4.6 on procurement of supplies and services ensuring maintenance of data that meets applicable quality criteria as well as training assessors as to means by which said quality assurance of critical supplies can be demonstrated.

Justification for Proposed Guidance: Previous experiences of laboratories have shown that a more efficient approach is necessary to ensure that procured supplies and services are of sufficient quality and are traceable.
