 - With the differences in method versions, and the implementation of new technology and laboratory developed methods, this impact of technology/prep method-based PTs would complicate the program in the following ways:
 - Data sets for scoring would be smaller, or in some cases based on single laboratory
 - The data sets that are currently pooled historically in determining acceptance limits would no longer be applicable
 - PT data is currently pooled to include all methods for acceptance limit determination, which takes different technology and prep methods into account
 - Multi-level PTs can be developed if an ARA is submitted to represent different sensitivities of methods and more modern technologies if ABs request this.

- The only PT Provider of these standards has discontinued preparing these standards, with only one more set to be available in April.
- Currently only 27 labs are accredited, and majority are in California
- Regulatory changes have resulted in a reduction in requirements for PT analysis and water system monitoring.
