# Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing Expert Committee Meeting June 15, 2022 1:00 pm Eastern

#### 1. Welcome and Announcements

Rami welcomed everyone to the teleconference. Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1, below. The agenda was approved by acclamation after a revision to include its approval, and is included as Attachment 2. The minutes of May 18 were then approved by unanimous vote after a motion by David seconded by Chandra, with John abstaining due to his absence from that meeting.

#### 2. Update on PT Interactions

Rami sent the updated table of standardized test conditions to the PTPEC Chair. Thus far, no response has been received. The final version accompanies the distribution of these minutes.

# 3. **Review and Update Technical Expert Language** (Formerly Technical Manager Qualifications)

TNI's Competency Task Force started to address the knowledge, skills, and abilities required by a Technical Manager, but after considerable discussion, determined that the requirements of the current Standard do not meet the needs nor the actual practice of many laboratories. They updated the concept, now referred to as Technical Expert, and discussed it at length including at least one conference session and a NELAP Accreditation Council meeting. That updated concept was referred to the renamed Quality Management Systems Expert Committee for further refinement prior to inclusion in the next revision of the Environmental Laboratory Sector Standard.

WET was asked to provide its preferred language for this new concept. As the committee had already discussed this at length, several years ago, only minor refinements were necessary – changing course credit hours to number of courses and a bit of reformatting. The new draft language at the end of the discussion is shown below, and the full document of the draft proposed revision is attached to the email distributing these minutes. Final approval was delayed until the July meeting so that all committee members would have the opportunity to comment.

Any technical expert of an accredited environmental laboratory engaged in toxicity testing shall be a person with at least a bachelor's degree in life sciences, environmental sciences, natural sciences or environmental engineering and a minimum of four (4) college-level courses in fields of biological or environmental sciences from an accredited institution, and have at least two (2) years of experience in all parts of the analysis of toxicity testing of environmental samples representative of the analyses for which the laboratory seeks or maintains accreditation.

A master's or doctoral degree in one of the above disciplines may be substituted for one (1) year of experience. Additional years of experience working in an environmental toxicity laboratory may be substituted for up to two of the courses specified above. One year of experience shall substitute for 1 course. Multiple years of substitution may be utilized, but each year substituted must be related to the learning of and proficiency across the scope of accreditation. Experience must be recent without any lapse in related work history of greater than one (1) year.

#### 4. Resume Revision of §6 DOC language

This discussion opened with consideration of how to clearly define "calendar year". Apparently,

some NELAP ABs have the timeframes codified in regulation, but not in a consistent way, and the TNI Glossary does not attempt to define it. The committee finally settled on "twelve months not to exceed thirteen months".

There was also some discussion about whether all DOCs could or should be included in the Quality Systems module. This was done in the 2003 NELAC Standard (only 1.5 pages, however, with no specifics for different analyses such as chemistry, microbiology, etc.), but that approach was abandoned for the 2009 TNI Standard.

At this point, time was expired. The discussion will resume with affirmation of these edits and then proceed to §6.3 for the July meeting.

#### 5. New Business

There was no new business. Stephen moved and John seconded that the meeting be adjourned.

#### 6. Next Meeting

The next teleconference meeting will be <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>July 20</u>, <u>at 1 pm Eastern</u>. All members will receive a WebEx invitation for screen sharing – expect that to arrive on the morning of the meeting date, as an email from Ilona Taunton. The agenda and any needed documents will be sent in advance.
