# Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing Expert Committee Meeting June 21, 2023 1:00 pm Eastern

#### 1. Welcome and Announcements

Rami welcomed everyone to the teleconference. The agenda (see Attachment 2 below) was approved by unanimous consent. Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1, below. The minutes of April 19 were approved unanimously after a motion by Stephen, seconded by Chandra, and the minutes of May 17 were approved unanimously after a motion by Stephen, also seconded by Chandra.

#### 2. New Member Election

Darrin Greenstein of the Southern California Coastal Water Research Project applied for voting membership as a stakeholder of the "other" category. Rami invited Darrin to introduce himself, and his application was distributed to committee members with the meeting reminder. Stephen moved and Katie seconded that Darrin be approved for membership, and the vote was unanimously in favor. Welcome, Darrin, and thank you for joining us!

## 3. Updates

<u>PTPEC WET FoPT Subcommittee</u> – this group did not meet in June, as they await PT data that needs to be manually retrieved by at least one of the PT providers.

<u>SETAC Meeting Accreditation Session Presentations</u> – Katie has submitted two abstracts, one representing TNI and the other, her personal experience with accreditation. She expects that one will be approved as a poster presentation and the other as a speaker. Teresa also submitted an abstract for a presentation on proficiency testing. Decisions should be known by the July WET meeting.

### 4. Review of Draft §7.1.3

The list of definitions used in WET testing, provided by Teresa earlier remain to be discussed. Not all of these will be used in the module, only the terms actually appearing in the module, but the full list will be made available on the WET committee's web page for the community. Lynn explained the existence of a still-draft TNI Glossary, now sorted according to whether terms are in the Standard or not, and has provided a copy of the Glossary to Teresa, as we must either use the definitions there or seek to have them modified to include WET aspects, if that is necessary. We believe that most of the WET terms will not exist in the Glossary and may or not eventually be included there.

Rami chose to talk through the revisions needed for sections 7.1.3 and 7.1.4 instead of drafting those. A major discussion point was the use of control charts rather than test-over-test comparisons, and how to cite or include the instructions for control charts that are in some of the method manuals while making their use a requirement for all testing – this language will be included in §7.1.2 which Stephen committed to revising. Control charts may be allowed to supplant reference toxicant tests in certain cases – these will need to be identified and specified. Additionally, the committee will need to either provide guidance or requirements for correcting procedures when control charts are "off".

An additional discussion point, about §7.1.4, was that not all tests will require PMSD (Percent Minimum Significant Difference, for hypothesis testing only), and the dose-response relationship

needs to be evaluated and determined satisfactory before the PMSD is calculated. Criteria for acceptable dose-response curves must be included in the module. Relevant information is in §10.2.6.2.f of the method guidance, and Teresa will cross-reference that language with what is in the regulations.

#### 5. New Business

There was no new business. Rami noted that the WET committee normally skips meeting in August, and that he plans to do so this year as well. Teresa moved to adjourn and Darrin seconded. Approval was unanimous.

## 6. Next Meeting

The next teleconference meeting is scheduled for <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>July 19</u>, <u>2023</u>, <u>at 1 pm Eastern</u>. A Microsoft Teams link for screen-sharing or just a telephone option will be provided with the agenda and any needed documents, in advance of the meeting.
