Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing Expert Committee Meeting September 20, 2023 1:00 pm Eastern

1. Welcome and Announcements

Rami welcomed everyone to the teleconference. The agenda (see Attachment 2 below) was approved by unanimous consent. Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1, below. The minutes of July 19 were approved unanimously after a motion by Stephen, seconded by Darrin, with John abstaining due to his absence.

Two new members applied to become voting members of WET: Gretchen Welfinger of NY ELAB (an AB stakeholder) and Elizabeth West, formerly of LA DEQ and now retired (an "other" stakeholder). Rami requested that their election be conducted by email prior to the meeting, in order to save time. On September 13, separate emails were sent for each individual, so that their applications could be forwarded and the voting process clearly delineated for each one. Darrin moved and Beth seconded that Gretchen be elected, and seven votes were cast in favor of her election with one member not voting. John moved and Darrin seconded that Elizabeth be elected, and eight votes were cast in favor. Welcome to WET, Gretchen, and welcome back, Elizabeth!

Additionally, since the committee was no longer in danger of becoming unbalanced, Rami suggested that Katie Payne be restored to voting membership. Several months ago, Katie had stepped down to associate status in order to maintain balance. This election was also conducted by email sent September 15. John moved and Darrin seconded that Katie be re-elected to voting membership, and six (of ten) votes were cast in favor, with four individuals not voting (a majority vote in favor). Welcome back, Katie!

There remains an opportunity for one additional voting member of the "lab" stakeholder category to join the committee. All active associate members are invited to apply, and if there is more than one applicant, a version of ranked voting will be used to determine the next new member.

2. Updates

<u>PTPEC WET FoPT Subcommittee</u> – PT data have begun to arrive, but more are expected, so meetings have not resumed.

<u>SETAC Meeting Accreditation Session Presentations</u> – Katie's "demystifying" abstract (about her personal experience with NELAP accreditation) was approved as a poster presentation and her TNI abstract as an oral presentation, both on Thursday of conference week, and Teresa's PT presentation will be an oral presentation on Tuesday of conference week. Both sessions are about accreditation and the differences between Canada and the US. The conference itself is in Louisville, November 12-16.

3. Revising the Module

Teresa provided her promised revisions to §7.1.2 and §7.1.3. Points made in the discussion were captured in the draft and broader concepts are summarized here:

- The Cusum chart information was updated
- Reference toxicant was changed to SRT

- Added requirement to distinguish test temperatures among different samples (as appropriate)
- Teresa is checking to see if control charts must be log or not
- Including information from regulatory "errata" updates is crucial but those are not included in the method manuals so that later requirements should be included (or at least mentioned) in this module
- Some requirements from the manual got added to the module w/ renumbering as needed
- Point made that the test method is for the biological endpoint, not the data analyses
- Need to ensure that the standard does not conflict with CA state requirements (add caveat "unless permit requires otherwise") – note added
- In 7.1.6, distinguish between flow-through and static/static renewal
- Language about temperature checks "daily versus 24 hours needs further consideration
- Need either special thermometers or continuous monitoring to ensure that temps do not go out of bounds (too high or too low within the time period, not just at time of measurement if once daily)
- The current (added?) language adds requirements on top of the method requirements
- Any surrogate test must be a true surrogate might be appropriate for some West Coast methods?
- What is "reagent grade water"? Teresa will investigate and resolve
- Terminology available for use versus used, which is the better phrasing?
- Use of negative control for chlorinating agent is a "should" in method but a requirement in the Standard (no need to add dechlorinating agent to the control)
- Everything from 7.2 and 7.3 is now in 7.1 (?)

The review of the available modified text was finished at the end of this meeting. Additional revisions are likely for §7.1-7.4 as several points required follow-up.

Since the meeting's changes, the draft module has been cleaned up to remove old comments (from Rewa) and to accept formatting changes, in hopes that it will be somewhat easier to read.

4. New Business

There was no new business. Teresa moved to adjourn and Stephen seconded. Approval was unanimous.

5. Next Meeting

The next teleconference meeting is scheduled for <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>October 18</u>, <u>2023</u>, <u>at 1 pm</u> <u>Eastern</u>. A Microsoft Teams link for screen-sharing or just a telephone option will be provided with the agenda and any needed documents, in advance of the meeting.
