Whole Effluent Toxicity Testing Expert Committee Meeting November 30, 2022 1:00 pm Eastern

1. Welcome and Announcements

Rami welcomed everyone to the teleconference. This meeting was rescheduled due to the SETAC meeting being the third week of November. Since the last meeting, Bruce Weckworth resigned from the committee, so balance was restored.

Attendance is recorded in Attachment 1, below. Without a quorum present, no business could be conducted but update and discussion of changes to the draft module continued. Both the September 21 and October 19 minutes will be withheld from posting to the website until they can be officially approved.

2. Updates from SETAC and WET FoPT Subcommittee

SETAC Meeting

Five committee members participated in this conference, which was in Pittsburgh, PA this month. All agreed that it was a good meeting, with good sessions especially for the aquatic toxicity interest group, with several "hot topics" introduced and discussed.

WET FoPT Subcommittee of PTPEC

The newly constituted WET FoPT Subcommittee of PTPEC met briefly to elect a chair (Craig Huff of Waters/ERA). Other subcommittee members are Rami, Ginger, Pete, and Carl Kircher (FL). Rami will share with them all of the various documents this committee has created to explain and promote the goal of having comparable results from WET PTs.

3. Election

With no quorum, the election of Beth Biller and re-election of Teresa as an Affiliate Member could not be conducted. If there is not a quorum for the December meeting, this election can be conducted by email.

4. Revision of V1M7

Definitions

Teresa was not available; this discussion will take place at a later meeting. Christina Henderson agreed to provide a draft definition for "similar technologies".

Affirm edits to §6.3, continue creating/editing §6 -- 6.4, 6.5

There were no specific changes requested to §6.3, but discussion revealed a need to clarify that not all analysts must be trained on and demonstrate competency for each of the tasks identified in the Note. Notes are not enforceable but in this case, intended to guide the application of the competency demonstration requirement. Additional clarifying language was added near the beginning of section 6.3.

Everything in sections 6.4 and 6.5 appears to be addressed in the new language of earlier subsections 6.1, 6.2, and 6.3. <u>Committee members are asked to review this deletion to ensure that nothing else is needed in the remaining text.</u>

Revision to Essential QC in Technical Requirements

The outline drafted during the April 2021 meeting was briefly discussed, and Rami asked that committee members please consider what (and how much) QC needs to be included in §7. Some discussion about the phrase "The resulting data shall be recorded in such a way that trends are detectable and, where practicable, statistical techniques shall be applied to the reviewing of the results", in the opening paragraph of §7 led to a determination that not everything needs to be subjected to trend analysis, and thus further clarification will need to be drafted for this revision.

5. New Business

Rami asked that everyone review the most recent changes to §6.3 (and the deletion of 6.4and 6.5), and consider what QC needs to be included as requirement(s) in the Standard.

6. Next Meeting

The next teleconference meeting is rescheduled for <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>December 21, at 1 pm</u> <u>Eastern</u>. We will change to using Microsoft Teams for screen-sharing, and the link with alternate telephone option will be shared along with the agenda and any needed documents, when those are sent with the meeting reminder.
